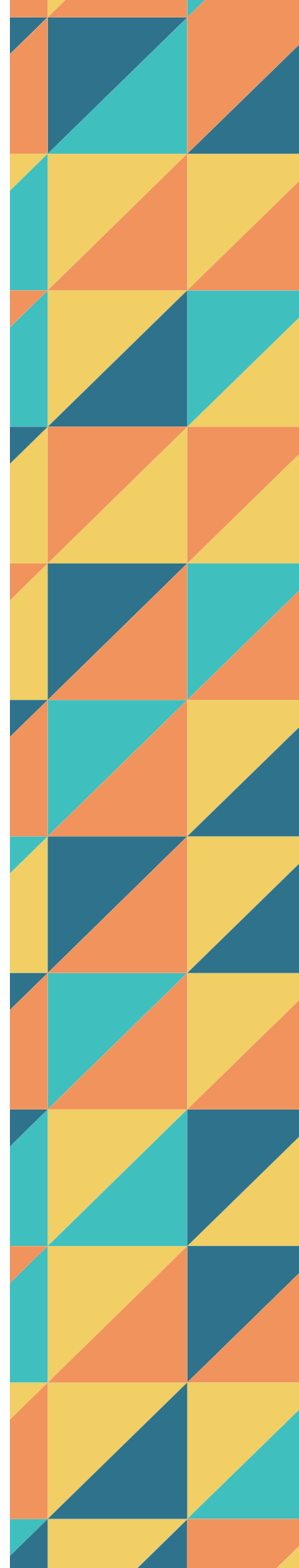

Transportation During COVID-19

Access Healthcare and Treatment Without Putting Others at Risk

The Milwaukee County Department on Aging is coordinating transportation to medical appointments for adults who have been exposed to COVID-19.

Who: Any adult in Milwaukee County who has tested positive for COVID-19, exhibited symptoms or was directly exposed to COVID-19.

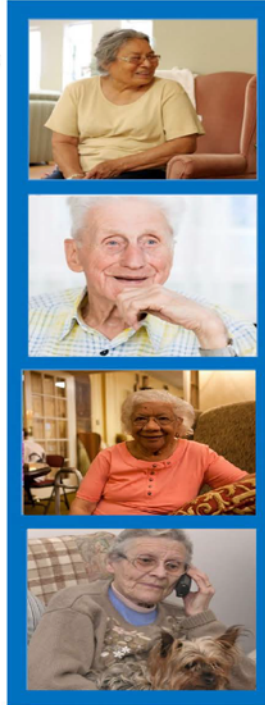
What: Transportation to medical or mental health appointments.

How: Call the Aging Resource Center to learn if you may be eligible for this transportation service. If you are found eligible, there is no cost for these rides.

Our goal is to provide critical access to healthcare for adults who have been exposed to COVID-19 and to prevent the spread of this virus by providing a safe transportation alternative.

Aging & Disability Resource Center

1. Any qualifying adult resident 18+
2. All rides provided by this program are free to the rider.
3. Individuals who have access to the Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) benefit through Medicaid should contact MTM at 866-907-1493 to schedule their rides and not access this service.
4. It is not Transit Plus. It is a special COVID-19+ transportation service administered by the Milwaukee County Department on Aging in partnership with the Department of Health and Human Services and the Milwaukee County Transit System.
5. It is for non-emergency medical appointments and treatment only:
 - medically necessary non-emergency medical or mental health appointments,
 - medically necessary treatment and ongoing services such as dialysis, chemotherapy, etc.
6. COVID-19 or other required testing, or isolation facilities.
7. "Medically necessary" means that the appointment has been confirmed by a healthcare professional as non-elective.
8. Referrals should be provided at least 24 – 48 hours in advance of the needed ride for an appointment.
9. Generally, the services will only run Monday-Friday, unless there are ongoing treatment needs (such as dialysis) on the weekend.
10. Service is curb to curb. For individuals with mobility impairment, a wheelchair accessible vehicle is available and the drivers are trained to assist, but this is not an ambulance service. Durable medical equipment can be accommodated.
11. Transport anywhere in Milwaukee County, or within five (5) miles of the Milwaukee County border.
12. Riders needing our service should call the Aging Resource Center directly or be referred by one of our County partners – Disability Resource Center, Disability Services Division, Behavioral Health Division, Housing, or Milwaukee County Transit System (Transit Plus).
13. Appointments can be made for single or recurring appointments through May 26, 2020 or up to one month after the exposure to COVID-19. One personal caretaker can accompany if absolutely necessary

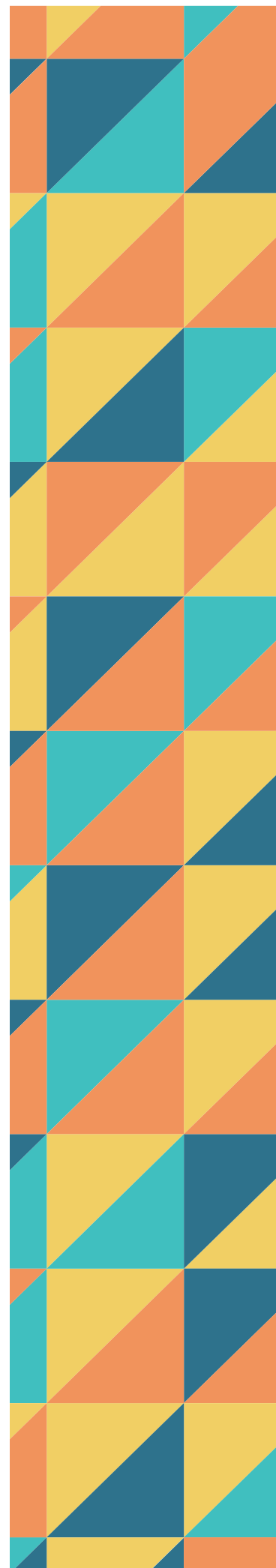

Additional Testing Locations

The Wisconsin National Guard's will hold special COVID-19 testing events beginning Monday, May 11th. The National Guard will set up testing sites on the city's north and south sides at the following locations:

- **Midtown Center - 5760 W. Capitol Drive**
- **UMOS - 2701 S. Chase Avenue**

These testing sites are open to the public and will operate from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily. You can walk up or drive up to the site. Each site will have the capacity to test up to 500 people per day. Anyone who wants to get tested can simply show up. No appointment is needed and there is no cost. You do not need to have any symptoms. Essential workers, frontline workers and their families are encouraged to get tested.
